



House rules

In the RadBOX we want to **share our knowledge about bicycle repair and help you to help yourself**. Under these aspects you will receive support from volunteer repair helpers.

This support includes: *Investigation of the defect and advice, provision of tools, measuring instruments and (to some extent) materials needed for repair in small quantities.*

The service is **not a commercial offer** and is **free of charge**. However, the team would be pleased to receive a **donation** to help cover the expenses of this event. Materials and spare parts have to be provided by yourself. To a small extent spare parts can be provided by us. We will support you as far as possible with the procurement of spare parts.

A repair attempt is only possible with **your participation**, and only under acceptance of these house rules. This is **explicitly not** a repair shop. There is no right to repair, success or reassembly (in case of abort of a repair).

The indication of personal data beyond the declaration of consent (name and signature) is voluntary.

With your signature you confirm your agreement with these rules and the limitation of liability.

If you do not agree with the house rules and the limitation of liability, we must ask you to leave the event.

Limitation of liability

We would like to point out that with the permission to participate in today's event no legal-business commitment is entered into, i.e. **no contract is concluded**.

The liability for any possible damage (including consequential damage) to your property, body, life or health **is limited to intent**. This applies to the event format and the organizer itself, but also to the employees/helpers.

Helpers can cancel a repair attempt (with good reason) if a repair is not possible (e.g. needed spare part not available, parts missing). Any necessary disposal is the responsibility of the visitor.
